Acadia Sights and Sounds Tour

Saturday, September 11, 2010 12pm-4pm

Come and experience the wildlife and outdoors that Acadia National Park is known for. The bus tour of Acadia will be coordinated with an expert who will share the stories behind the sights and provide a running commentary on the geology, ocean, plant, and animal life. There will be several stops at points of interest within the park for observation, exploration, and photos. Dress for the weather, wear comfortable shoes, and bring a pair of binoculars if you have them.

Whale Watching Trip

Board a high-speed catamaran and head straight out to sea for whale watching. We'll get out into the gulf of Maine quickly and have lots of time for viewing Humpback, Finback and Minke whales. Full information and an educational narration will be provided. A naturalist will point out whales and other wildlife that may be encountered. The catamaran features indoor cabins, food, and a bar. The tour will proceed rain or shine, bring an umbrella and wear pants and a *warm* jacket as we will be 25 miles out at sea and it will be very chilly. A picture ID is needed in order to board the ship.
